DR. SURESH KUMAR Scientist -E Wildlife Institute of India, Deharadun

A wildlife biologist and currently working as a senior scientist in the Department of Endangered Species Management at the Wildlife Institute of India. He provide advisory to the Ministry of Environment, forest and climate change, Government of India and State Forest Departments. His current research include migration and movement studies of amur Falcons in North east India, Migratory Cranes and Flamingos in Gujrath, Spot billed pelicans in Karnataka, on the long distance migratory Barns Swallows and Pied Cuckoo along with the house sparrows in Uttarakhand. Recently, he has initiated a study to take the migration of olive Ridley sea turtle along the Maharashtra Coast.

He as been associated with Aaranyak since 1994 as a volunteer. He is a avid researcher and has discovered several new species of amphibians including Orange Sticky Frog. Currently he is leading Manas Tiger Conservation Programme. He also lead the Participatory Natural Resource Management Programme at the Kaziranga - Karbi DR. 
