#### **CONCEPT NOTE:**

#### RE-SITING AND RE-CITING TRENDS IN ENGLISH LITERATURE AND LANGUAGE

The landscape of English Studies is changing faster than you can say "GPS". Over the last few decades, the locationary points that dominated the production of English literature have already shifted from the Anglo-American First World centres to Third World postcolonial margins and beyond. New writers are emerging from places like Vietnam, Tunisia, Sri Lanka, Bhutan, Singapore and Fiji. Overcoming the anxiety of colonial history and riding on the optimism of postnational consciousness, writers from hitherto unknown locations are adding a rich, diverse and exciting body of work to world literature. The constantly mutating field of literatures in English is also impacting the way 'englishes' are being used globally and locally. No less powerful is the impact of new media technologies that are giving a 'digital turn' to humanities in general. Both literary and linguistic changes are creating fresh pathways that invite serious and scholarly engagement. It hopes to re-site emerging trends and re-cite a critical discourse from varied perspectives.

# Two Day International E-conference on

# Emerging Trends in Literature and Language

4th - 5th October 2021

The two-day International e Conference on Emerging Trends in English Literature and Language' was jointly organized by Hislop College, Nagpur, J. M. Patel College. Bhandara, and Smt. Binzani Mahila Mahavidyalaya, Nagpur on 4th and 5th October 2021. The E-conference was inaugurated at the hands of Dr. Urmila Dabir, Chairperson, Board of Studies in English. Rashtrasant Tukadoji Maharaj Nagpur University, Nagpur.

The e-mail conference received overwhelming response as 172 delegates registered for this literary feast. 18 research scholars participated in a paper presentation session and discussion. The research papers of 81 scholars from all over the globe have been published in an international E journal, **Langlit**, an International Peer-Reviewed Open Access Journal.

Earlier, the Principals of the collaborating colleges extended their greetings to the delegates. Linking the creative expression of Bhutanese writings to the oral tradition and emergence of folk genre since 1990s, the keynote speaker, Dr S Chitra, Head, PG Department of English, Yonphula Centenary college. Royal University of Bhutan, brought alive Bhutan's culture, spirituality, history and popular beliefs through her address. Dr Laxman Gnawali. Professor and Head, Department of Language Education, Kathmandu University, Nepal, in the first plenary lecture of the day, elaborated on how writers, in the course of history, responded to the plight brought by the contagion. He also delved into how our people shared their experiences on the social media platform during the pandemic. The session was chaired by Dr Sunil Kumar Navin. Principal, Nabira Mahavidyalaya Katol. In the second plenary session, Dr Kamala Naiker, Head, Department of Language. Literature and Communication, School of Humanities and Arts, University of Fiji, elucidated how V. S. Naipaul's texts are discussed to expose the issues faced by the Indo-Trinidadian society in the Caribbean. The session was chaired by Dr. Priya Wanjari, Principal of Santaji Mahavidyalaya, Nagpur.

Underlining that the virus has not just attacked our corporeal entity but also the western cognitive empire, Dr. Dinesh Kumar, Associate Professor, V. G. Vaze College, Mumbai, made the delegates revisit the inter- disciplinary field of Health Humanities, which has gained momentum in the wake of the pandemic. He went on to point out that the field of Humanities can help us not only understand environmental injustice, devastation and the resulting pandemic destruction, but also be a means of healing and reorienting. Dr Mustajeeb Khan. Professor, Department of English, Dr Babasaheb Ambedkar University, Aurangabad, was the resource person for the session. Dr Ruta Dharmadhikari chaired the second plenary session.

Dr Khan said that there was an urgent need to re-read drama and help people once again have a participative experience of theater. The Chief Guest of the Valedictory function was Dr Akhilesh Peshwe, Principal, Dharampeth M P Deo Memorial Science College. The E Conference received a good response as a total of 172 participants registered for the conference. 18 participants took part in the paper presentation session.

M Patel College, Bhandara, introduced the concept of the conference and Dr. Suchita Marathe, Head, Department of English, proposed a vote of thanks at the inaugural function.
