DAY-1

DATE: MONDAY, 20 SEPTEMBER 2021

An '8 Day Online National Level Faculty Development-cum-Orientation programme was organised jointly by J. M. Patel College, Bhandara, Santaji Mahavidyalaya, Nagpur, Dharampeth M. P. Deo Memorial Science College, Nagpur, Dr. M.K. Umathe College, Nagpur, Yashoda Girls' College, Nagpur, and Bar. Sheshrao Wankhede College, Khaparkheda, started on Monday, 20th to 27th September 2021.



DATE: TUESDAY, 21 SEPTEMBER 2021

The session commenced with welcome address by Dr. Akhilesh Peshwe, Principal, Dharampeth M.P. Deo Memorial Science College, Nagpur. Principals Dr. Priya Wanjari, Dr. Vikas Dhomane, Dr.R.Tale, Dr.D.V.Naik, Dr. Vandana Bhagdikar and Dr. Dhanraj Shete graced the inaugural function. The participants joined through ZOOM and YOUTUBE for this workshop.

Criterion-II -Teaching Learning and Evaluation was elaborated and explained in detail by Dr. Ajay Gor, Principal, Pramukh Swami Science and H.D. Patel Arts College, Kadi, Gujarat. He exemplified the seven key indicators and sixteen matrices at length and explained distribution of weightages. He underlined the importance of teacher's role in the students grooming. He elaborated Students Satisfaction Survey initiated by the NAAC soon after the submission of RAR and requirement of 70% students' feedback submission. He told about the lists of documents regarding intake of students, reserved seats for students and number of teachers. He mentioned certain practices to be implemented for the slow and advanced learners. eeHe advocated use of ICT, Experiential Learning, Project based learning and participative learning. 
DATE: WEDNESDAY, 22 SEPTEMBER 2021

DAY-4


DATE: THURSDAY, 23 SEPTEMBER 2021

She explained the role of ICT and Research in the globalized world. She urged the teachers to be active researchers, and look to convert information into knowledge.

She said that useful research projects need to be taken up which are useful to the society and it is the responsibility of each HEI to develop an appropriate 'Research Culture' She said that the institution need to serve the community through extension, which is a social responsibility and a core value of this criterion. She said that the HEIs need to prepare a roadmap for extension activities and evolve appropriate policies and practices by making adequate resources available.

She stressed that through encouraging active research involvement of teachers and scholars as well as recognizing achievement of teachers through research many milestones can be achieved. She concluded that an ecosystem for Research and Extension has to be created to ensure benefit to the society.




DATE: SATURDAY, 25 SEPTEMBER 2021

She was welcomed by Dr. D. V. Naik, Principal, Dr. M. K. Umathe College, Nagpur. In her deliberation, she explained that NAAC had laid special emphasis on academic, administrative function of the HEIs as well as on the emerging issues. She appealed the colleges to keep Vision and Mission in mind while framing them.

She advised that the budget must reflect in the audited statement and Policy document must be prepared on the e-governance. She said that the importance of faculty empowerment has great significance in the institutional development plan. She said that financial management and resource mobilization includes annual budgeting, optimum utilization of finances, mobilization of resources, allocation of finances, income and expenditure statements and regular internal and external auditing. She urged the IQAC to initiate steps like Academic Audit, Green Audit, Gender Audit, NIRF, Publication of college journal and MoU for industrial work experience. She mentioned that one must go through the revised composition of IQAC and constitute accordingly.




