Annual Gender Sensitization Action Plan (2023-2024)

The institution has made a number of efforts to promote gender equality and inclusivity, foster respectful relationships and communication. Strategies are awareness and education by conducting workshops, organizing lectures on gender-related issues; screen films and documentaries on gender equality. It also offers a setting where boys and girls can collaborate with a feeling of personal security and dignity. Moreover, it uses a variety of initiatives to raise awareness of gender issues and foster an atmosphere that is supportive of gender justice.

Institution plans to continue and strengthen these initiatives by involving all stake holders, including Internal Complaints Cell and NGOs in the current academic session 2023-24.

Boys and girls have the same possibilities to participate in NSS, NCC, cultural and sporting events. Around 30% of the students in the NCC unit are girls. Girls make up more than half of the pupils in the NSS unit. Women make-up over 30% of the staff strength.

To further sensitize the staff and students and to promote gender equity, the college plans to organize the following activities in the academic year 2023-24: -

- To organize Self-Defence training program for girls.
- To organize various programs & guest lecture related to Gender Equality.
- To celebrate Savitribai Phule Jayanti.
- To celebrate International Women's Day.
- To organize Seminar/Workshops on Nutrition, Health and Hygiene for girls.
- To organize the workshops on women's issues and challenges.

Some of these programmes will be organized in collaboration with NGOs. These efforts, we hope will go in long way in sensitizing the students and staff on gender issues.
